

ANTI-HPV-VACCINATION FOR FREE!

(usual costs: 600 Euro)

- The human papillomavirus (HPV) is responsible for causing cervix cancer, labia cancer and genital warts.
- Because of various sexual partners, female sexworker run a high risk of getting infected.
- 3 vaccinations within one year are necessary to be protected.
- Lifelong protection (no additional vaccinations throughout lifetime) is guaranteed.
- The Vaccination is recommended for women and men, beginning with the age of nine.
- Do not get the Anti-HPV-Vaccination if you are pregnant or run a fever.
- The pregnancy-protection of the pill is not reduced by the vaccination.
- The annual pap smear at your gynecologist is not being replaced by this vaccination.

ANTI-HPV-VACCINATION

Do not use in case of:

- Allergic reaction or intolerance to a substance of content
- Pregnancy or if you think you might be pregnant
- Illness with a high fever

Please speak to your doctor if:

- you have (blood) coagulation disorder
- your immune system is weak (for example because of HIV, strong meds, autoimmune disease)

The following side effects are possible:

10% of immunized people have local pain, swelling or redness at the puncture site and/or get a headache

1% of immunized people have a bruise and/or an itch at the puncture site, pain in the local extremities, run a fever or feel sick.

0,1% get a nettle rash

0,01% have difficulty of breathing

In rare cases the following is possible: unconsciousness, stiffness, muscle contractions, muscle weakness, prickling of arms and feet, confusion (Guillain-Barré-syndrom), dizziness, sickness, joint pain, muscle pain, unusual tiredness or weakness, shivering, easy bruising or bleeding, infection of the skin at the puncture site.
